

Awareness raising among rightsholders



 Raising awareness on human rights at the grassroots level is very important because this is where a lot of cases of child abuse and exploitation are being reported • Advocacy and capacity building work among duty-bearers



 School-based and community-based duty-bearers are equipped with information on various laws for the protection of women and children and are oriented on the mandatory response on dealing with child abuse and exploitation cases

• Reintegration Services

When the children have recovered at the Preda Home and when there is no more threat to her safety in the community, she is reintegrated with her nearest and supportive family/relatives.

Aftercare Services

The reintegrated children continue to be monitored (online, by phone) regularly by the Preda aftercare social worker to monitor her situation, they are still provided with legal aid and educational assistance to ensure that these children are in school and are no longer re-victimized. The children as well as their parents/guardians also receive psycho-social interventions done online.
